During the ITE Annual Business Meeting on Sunday, August 9, International President Kenneth H. Voigt, P.E., spoke of ITE's toolbox for the future, highlighting new resources that members will benefit from next year, such as the *Traffic Signal Maintenance Handbook* and a new academic journal that will be produced twice a year. Ken also detailed the many initiatives that ITE undertook this year, including creating special task forces on roundabouts and energy and climate change. ITE has also expanded its international initiatives, conducting a Canadian traffic signal report card and establishing Webinars for our members in Australia and New Zealand.

Other highlights from the business meeting included addresses by International President-Elect Paul Eng-Wong and International Vice President-Elect Robert C. Wunderlich, who will join Kenneth H. Voigt and Thomas W. Brahms to comprise the 2010 Executive Committee starting January 1, 2010.
