Dr. de Villa was the Medical Officer of Health at Peel Public Health, the local public health agency serving the 1.4 million residents of the cities of Mississauga and Brampton and the town of Caledon. Peel Public Health is one of the largest public health departments in the country and a leader in public health practice in Canada, particularly as it relates to the built environment and changing the way communities are designed and built. Effective March 27, 2017, Dr. de Villa became the Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto.

Dr. de Villa holds an undergraduate degree from McGill University. She continued her studies at the University of Toronto where she completed both her master of health science and her medical degree. She subsequently became a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada, specializing in Public Health and Preventive Medicine.
