TRANSPORTATION EDUCATION COUNCIL INNOVATION IN EDUCATION AWARD

Deadline: April 1st

The purpose of the ITE Transportation Education Council Innovation in Education Award is to advance innovation in transportation education by recognizing an individual, university department, or organization/learning institution that has implemented an innovative technique or program to attract, develop and/or retain transportation professionals. This award may be given annually.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Individuals, university departments, and organization/learning institutions are all eligible candidates for this award.
- ITE membership is not a requirement to apply for this award.

SUBMITTAL PROCEDURE:

- The submission should be a unique or innovative technique/program used to attract students into a career in surface transportation (any mode or discipline), or develop and/or retain current transportation professionals.
- The submission should be no more than two pages plus examples of program material.
- Please send submission electronically as one file in a PDF format **no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 1st** to:
