TRANSPORTATION PLANNING COUNCIL BEST PROJECT AWARD

Deadline: March 1st

The ITE Transportation Planning Council Best Project Award is bestowed on a project that applied innovative techniques to a transportation related issue/problem in a study or planning effort. Projects that will benefit the profession through greater understanding of a transportation issue and for the betterment of the public through effective and innovative solutions are encouraged to be submitted for consideration. Submissions that effectively communicate a problem statement, clearly outline methods used, highlight results, advance feasible and reliable solutions, and demonstrate the benefits to the public will be given the highest consideration. The emphasis is on an applied project, study and/or program, not research, design or construction.

ELIGIBILITY:

- For a project to be considered eligible for the award it must have been fully completed during the previous calendar year.
- A Transportation Planning Council member should have had a significant role in conducting the project.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

- Originality
- Quality
- Significance
- Comprehensiveness
- Transferability to other places or agencies

SUBMITTAL PROCEDURE:

- Please submit a cover letter and an electronic copy of the written product (report, plan, etc).
- Cover letters should describe how the project fulfilled each of the five evaluation criteria.
- Please send submission electronically as one file in a PDF format **no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 1st** to:
