Membership Eligibility and Dues:

ITE has several grades of membership. You will be granted the appropriate grade based on your education and experience and billed accordingly once your application has been accepted. Dues are billed annually, and will be pro-rated for mid-year applicants. To view the dues schedule, visit www.ite.org/membership/membership_fees.asp.

Minimum Requirements for ITE Voting Membership:

You must have an undergraduate or graduate degree in a transportation related field from a school of recognized standing and you must be active in transportation or traffic engineering work, OR if you do not have an undergraduate or graduate degree in a transportation related field, you must have five years of professional experience in transportation or traffic engineering work.

Minimum Requirements for ITE Institute Affiliate (Non-Voting) Membership: You must be engaged in traffic or transportation engineering work OR you must be employed in a related field and contribute to the work of or assist transportation professionals OR you must be employed in commerce or industry with an interest in the transportation profession.
