He has extensive experience in preparing transportation planning studies, traffic impact studies, signal timing and coordination, evaluating intersection/corridor operational improvements, safety evaluations, public engagement, and expert witness reports/testimony. He has experience with complete street planning, traffic calming, master planning, interchange justification, and change of access studies.

Active in ITE since the beginning of his career, he is an ITE Fellow and served as Chair of the Public Relations Committee and on the Keystone CO Annual Meeting Organizing Committee for the Western District. For the past two years, he has served as Vice-Chair of the Traffic Engineering Council. Chuck has published and presented 14 papers at various ITE meetings and in the *ITE Journal*; won the ITE Western District Best Paper Award in 2009 and the Traffic Engineering Council Technical Achievement Award in 2019 for his role in organizing and preparing new Traffic Calming Fact Sheets. Over the past three years, he has organized and taught several ITE webinars on diverse topics such as traffic calming techniques, work zone traffic management, route guidance data and COVID



impacts on transportation. He is currently involved in an update to the ITE Speed Trip recommended practice report.
