

## **NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT**

ITE- A Community of Transportation Professionals

### ***Next Generation Traffic Management Data Dictionary V1.0***

The final draft version of the National Transportation Communications for Next Generation Traffic Management Data Dictionary (NGTMDD) v1.0 Application Profile's Recommended Standards (RS) were approved as Recommended Standards (RS) by the NGTMDD Steering Committee Voting Members, made up of representatives of American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO), ITE- A Community of Transportation Professionals, and At-Large representatives on **March 3rd, 2026**. ITE intends to adopt this standard under the project assuming no final appeals are received. Please check the ITE website <https://www.ite.org/technical-resources/standards/next-generation-tmdd/> for a notice as to whether these versions have been adopted by ITE. When adopted, this standard will be jointly published by ITE and AASHTO.

#### **Effective Date of the NOI for these Standards**

► The deadline to appeal the adoption of these standards as ITE standards is:  
**April 30<sup>th</sup> 2026, close of business.**

#### **How to View the Draft Standards**

Between **March 31<sup>st</sup>, and April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026** the final draft versions of the *Standards Development Report, Volume 1 and 2, JSON Schema, and Comments Matrix Table* are available to review on the ITE Website at:

In addition to the above the ITE web site contains supporting documents and files, as well as instructions on reporting comments and appeals. If no appeals are filed, the ITE International Board of Direction (IBOD), and AASHTO will ballot this standard and it will be available for a no-cost free download for a period of at least one year. The 508 Compliant versions will also be available.

#### **How to File an Appeal**

If you wish to appeal the adoption of the NGTMDD v1.0, submit a written appeal by the close of business on **April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, to:

The written appeal shall state the nature of the objection(s) including any adverse effects, the step(s) of the ITE procedures or the section(s) of the standard that are at issue, and the specific remedial action(s) that would satisfy the appellant's concerns. Any previous efforts to resolve the objection(s) and the outcome of each shall also be noted.

#### **If an Appeal is Received by ITE**

ITE Headquarters will work with the Steering Committee to develop a response. Within 30 days after receipt of the appeal, ITE Headquarters shall respond in writing to the appellant, specifically addressing each allegation of fact in the appeal to the extent possible.

If an appeal cannot be resolved informally in a manner consistent with the ITE procedures, ITE Headquarters shall initiate the process for the appointment of an *Appeals Panel* and will schedule a hearing. If the timeframe for the above actions extends beyond **April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, another notice shall be provided announcing a delay in the anticipated date of adoption by ITE.
