

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT

ITE- A Community of Transportation Professionals ITS Standards

NTCIP 1202 V04 Actuated Signal Controllers (ASC) Version 04

The final draft version of the National Transportation Communications for ITS Protocol (NTCIP) NTCIP 1202 V04 Actuated Signal Controllers (ASC) V04 Application Profile's Recommended Standards (RS) were approved as Recommended Standards (RS) by the NTCIP Joint Committee (JC) made up of representatives of American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO), ITE- A Community of Transportation Professionals, and the National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) on **July 10, 2025**. ITE intends to adopt this standard under the project assuming no final appeals are received. Please check the ITE website <https://www.ite.org/technical-resources/topics/standards/ntcip-1202-v04-actuated-signal-control-asc/> for a notice as to whether these versions have been adopted by ITE. When adopted, this standard will be jointly published by ITE, NEMA and AASHTO.

Effective Date of the NOI for these Standards

► The deadline to appeal the adoption of these standards as ITE standards is:
September 30, 2025, close of business.

In addition to the above the ITE web site contains supporting documents and files which are self-explanatory. If no appeals are filed, the ITE International Board of Direction (IBOD), AASHTO and NEMA will ballot this standard and it will be available for a no-cost free download for a period of at least one year. The 508 Compliant versions will also be available.

How to File an Appeal

If you wish to appeal the adoption of the NTCIP 1202 V04 ASC, submit a written appeal by the close of business on **September 30, 2025**, to:

The written appeal shall state the nature of the objection(s) including any adverse effects, the step(s) of the ITE procedures or the section(s) of the standard that are at issue, and the specific remedial action(s) that would satisfy the appellant's concerns. Any previous efforts to resolve the objection(s) and the outcome of each shall also be noted.

If an Appeal is Received by ITE

ITE Headquarters will work with the Working Group (WG) to develop a response. Within 30 days after receipt of the appeal, ITE Headquarters shall respond in writing to the appellant, specifically addressing each allegation of fact in the appeal to the extent possible.

If an appeal is not able to be resolved informally in a manner consistent with the ITE procedures, ITE Headquarters shall initiate the process for the appointment of an *Appeals Panel* and will schedule a hearing. If the timeframe for the above actions extends beyond **September 30, 2025**, another notice shall be provided announcing a delay in the anticipated date of adoption by ITE.
