## Notice of Intent to Adopt

Institute of Transportation Engineers Intelligent Transportation Systems Standard

*RSU Standard v01*

On May 24, 2021, *RSU Standard v01* was accepted as a Recommended Standard by the Roadside Unit Standardization (RSU) Working Group. The RSU Standardization Working Group is made up of representatives of the American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO), the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE), and the National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) and SAE International and IEEE 1609 Working Groups.

### **Effective date of the standard:**

The effective date when this "Notice of Intent to Adopt" is deemed complete as of July 1, 2021 close of business, if no appeal is received. The next and final step to adopt the standard is obtaining the approval of the ITE International Board of Direction. Under the terms of the MOU for ITS standards, the standard development process is deemed complete for this standard, once AASHTO, ITE and NEMA have individually approved the standard.

► The deadline to appeal the adoption of this standard as an ITE standard is:  
**July 1, 2021 close of business.**

### **How to view the draft standard:**

Between now and July 1, 2021, *RSU Standard v01* and the Standards Development Report are available on the ITE Website [RSU Standardization - Institute of Transportation Engineers \(ite.org\)](https://www.ite.org/RSU-Standardization)

### **If no appeal is received:**

The ITE International Board of Direction (IBOD) will ballot the standard and once approved by the IBOD, then the standard is deemed an ITE approved standard. It will be available for a no-cost free download for a period of at least one year.

### **How to file an appeal:**

If you wish to appeal the adoption of the *RSU Standard v01*, submit an appeal by close of business July 1, 2021 to:

The appeal shall state the nature of the objection(s) including any adverse effects, the step(s) of the ITE procedures or the section(s) of the standard that are at issue, and the specific remedial action(s) that would satisfy the appellant's concerns. Any previous efforts to resolve the objection(s) and the outcome of each shall also be noted.

### **If an appeal is received by ITE:**

ITE Headquarters will work with the ATC Joint Committee to develop a response. Within 30 days after receipt of the appeal, ITE Headquarters shall respond in writing to the appellant, specifically addressing each issue in the appeal to the extent possible. If an appeal is not able to be resolved informally in a manner consistent with the ITE procedures, ITE Headquarters shall initiate the process for the appointment of an *Appeals Panel* and will schedule a hearing.
