### **Project Presentation**

Submitters must agree to present the project (if awarded) during the ITE Roundabout Committee webinar on September 22, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. EDT, during National Roundabouts Week!

Runners-up submissions may be considered for the ITE Roundabout Committee webinar scheduled for December 15, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. EST.

## **Criteria**

- To be eligible, the roundabout project must have been constructed within the last 10 years.
- Describe the transformation of the location, corridor, or interchange with the project.
- Briefly describe how the project contributes to safety, traffic operations, and community enhancements.
- The nomination must be succinct, including a layout plan and technical information supporting the application theme of rightsizing roundabouts. Detailed design plans are not required.

## **Requirements**

- Nominations are due by June 24, 2026, at 12:00 a.m. EDT to the ITE Roundabout Committee Vice Chair, Claudio Figueroa [Claudio.Figueroa@burgessniple.com](mailto:Claudio.Figueroa@burgessniple.com)
- Judging will be based on the submittal that best conforms to the criteria.
- Submissions must be a single two-page PDF file. Maximum file size is 10 MB. Include project title and submitting organization in the file name.
- Links to ancillary material will not be considered.
