Entries due December 6, 2019

ITE’s STEM sub-committee has developed a competition encouraging members to engage in STEM-related classroom activities for K-12 as a way to celebrate National STEM month in November. All entry forms for this competition are due December 6th. This year, there will be two prizes awarded, one for a large event and one for a small event. The two winning entries will each be recognized with a **\$250 cash award to their Section or Chapter** which can be donated or used to develop additional K-12 STEM activities. The winning entries will be recognized in the February 2020 issue of the *ITE Journal*.

- Number of ITE members who participated or were involved in planning student events
- Number of K-12 students who participated in events
